

September 11, 2007 – Public Hearing

The Swain County Board of Commissioners held a Public Hearing on Tuesday, September 11, 2007. Present were Chairman Jones, Vice-Chair Lindsay, Commissioner Moon, Commissioner Carson and Commissioner Monteith.

Chairman Jones called the meeting to order.

Purpose

The purpose of this public hearing was to receive comments from the public regarding an application to be filed with the Local Government Commission for financing DSS Building renovations.

Kevin King, County Manager, noted there are two phases of financing.

This proposal is for \$900,000.00 without going to bid.

Sixty-five percent of money used for this expansion is federal and state dollars, the remainder will be paid through the County.

The expansion will include 18 new offices/meeting rooms, including 2 offices for Smoky Mountain Mental Health.

These improvements should last over an estimated 20 years.

Adjournment

Chairman Jones made a motion to adjourn the public hearing at this time. Commissioner Carson seconded the motion. A vote was unanimous.
