

September 5, 2019 – Special Session

The Swain County Board of Commissioners held an organizational meeting/special session on September 5, 2019. Present were Chairman Bushyhead, Vice-Chair Burns, Commissioner Parton, Commissioner Parsons and Commissioner Seagle.

Chairman Bushyhead called the meeting to order and led the pledge.

The purpose of this special session was to discuss the Sheriff's Department's salaries and consider the 7K Plan.

Kevin King relayed the 7K program was put into place many years ago by the previous sheriff and is based on an 86 hours plus comp time up to 480 hours.

Vice-Chair Burns made a motion to eliminate the 7K plan effective October 1, 2019. Commissioner Seagle seconded the motion. A vote was unanimous.

Commissioner Parsons made a motion to approve comp time buyout up to 240 hours for the Sheriff's Department employees. Vice-Chair Burns seconded the motion. A vote was unanimous.
